Are you interested in learning where your waste goes and how to properly sort it?

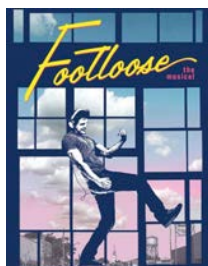
